Public Forum.

- 2 members of public present but no items raised

Finance Report –

- Current Account balance - £37,102.34, Deposit Account balance - £22493.24
- PD stated that it was imperative Trust accounts were submitted in a timely fashion and that we need to look to engage a firm of accountants to bring accounts up to date.

Parking licenses –

- PD raised the point that we need to inform residents who have licenses to park on Trust land of the new Trust banking arrangements in order that Standing orders can be amended accordingly.
- LE asked where the by-laws boards were situated in the village
- LE mentioned parking on Little Green

Maintenance Issues -

- The gate to the playing field is in poor condition and in need of replacement. PT to make enquiries of Suffolk Gates to ascertain cost of replacement.
- In the meantime, do we have sufficient keys to the existing gate. PT to make enquiries as to provision of new keys.
- PD to trim back growth of nettles around the gate on to the field
- Track to Little Green – the issues at hand with the track were explained to the residents present.
- LE to ask Newton Parish Council if the existing village notice boards can be utilised for Trust purposes, ie, notice of meetings.

Trust re-structure -

- Work to be ongoing but needed to resolve outstanding license issues as a priority in order to create capacity to focus on a re-structure. In the meantime, it was agreed that the Village Representative's position, currently Shonagh Shipp, should be promoted as the first point of contact for residents contact.
